## 10.2 Budget 2019

Highlights from Budget 2019 – Councillor White (Finance Committee Chair)

- Residential and commercial property mil rate increased .7 mils to offset lost revenue due to reduced property assessments (2.7%) and increase in expenses.
- All existing services are maintained.
- The Town will continue to seek government funding for its Capital Works Program (80/20 ratio with the Town borrowing its 20% of the project funding).
- Council is refocusing the Mussel Bed Soiree Concert in the Park to a festival and will still guarantee entertainment for this event.

Be it also resolved that pursuant to Section 111 of the Municipalities Act M-24, the Interfaith Goodwill Centre be exempt from the payment of 2019 business tax and water tax.
