## Policy # FN 07

## **Topic: DONATIONS**

## POLICY STATEMENT:

The Town of Lewisporte will give a donation to charitable, non-profit and recognized public service organizations upon request, subject to the guidelines listed below:

- 1. Must be a community of Lewisporte program or project; or organization of which the Town of Lewisporte is associated.
- 2. Must be a charitable or a non-profit organization and/or a recognized public service organization.
- 3. It is the intent of this policy to eliminate, wherever possible, a contribution which would result in double giving, ie: by residents and the Town Council.
- 4. Groups have to show evidence of having raised some of the required funds or be in the process of doing so.
- 5. Where practical, the town may allow the use of its facilities for benefit purposes, which may or may not be in addition to a financial contribution to the groups or individuals.
- 6. Age will not be a factor if the necessary guidelines are met.
- 7. Council shall determine the amount of the donation.
- 8. A community disaster, inside or outside Lewisporte would rate special consideration by Council and would not be restricted by these guidelines.
- 9. Suitable recognition of the town's contribution should be made and where appropriate representative of Council will attend functions, dinners, etc.
- 10. Donations may be made in cash or through the provision of goods or services.
- 11. All donations will be subject to availability of funding in the current municipal budget.
- 12. Because it recognizes the importance of promoting academic excellence and community involvement the Town of Lewisporte will annually award two scholarships valued at \$500 each to graduating students of Lewisporte Collegiate as per motion 07-150.
- 13. All donation requests must be in writing and completed on the attached application form.
